

Conscious Classroom Management Online Course Pricing* Guide:

There are many options for purchasing courses for teachers. In order of cost-effectiveness they are:

1. Teacher purchases individual course for themselves- zero cost to school or district.
2. School or District purchases a package of “unfacilitated” courses to give out to certain teachers- See costs and advantages/disadvantages below.
3. School or District purchases a package of “facilitated” courses to give out to certain teachers- See costs and advantages/disadvantages below.

Conscious Teaching Facilitated:

When Conscious Teaching facilitates the course, our expert trainers will be the people checking course work, responding to participant questions about the content, grading mid-terms and finals, and generally making sure all runs smoothly, both technically and educationally for each person taking the course. Technical problems will be resolved by Conscious Teaching or by Conscious Teaching's partners at PD360.

Benefits:

- Once purchased, client need do nothing except forward login instructions to participants
- Conscious Teaching handles all interactions with participants and resolves all technical and educational problems participants may encounter
- Conscious Teaching's expert trainers assess all course work, sending work back for revision when necessary, and following up with participants who do not progress on schedule through the course work
- Partial admin access can be granted to "site facilitators" for the purpose of looking through participant's course work as desired

Drawbacks:

- Costs more per person
- Client does not determine what satisfactory work looks like

Client Facilitated:

When the client facilitates the course, the purchasing school or district will designate a "course facilitator" who will be given total admin access to the course and sent written instructions on how to view each persons coursework and how to mark things as complete or incomplete and send messages to participants through the course. Conscious Teaching will be available to answer questions from the site-designated facilitator only, but not from course participants. Conscious Teaching and her partner group, PD360, will provide technical support as needed.

Benefits:

- Costs less per person
- Client can determine what satisfactory work looks like, control all assessments
- Client can tailor course to individual site needs

Drawbacks:

- Requires sustained commitment on the part of the designated site facilitator to keep up with participant questions, problems, and assessments for the duration of the course
- Site facilitator is not familiar with the program or the tech support system, which may result is time lost and/or frustration as part of the inevitable learning curve
- Participants do not have the ear of trained experts in the field

Units and Credits:

This course can be taken for 36 PD hours only or for 36 PD hours plus either 3 Continuing Educations Units or 3 Graduate Quarter Credits. The pricing scale explained in the pages above is for the “PD hours only” option.

Applying for Units/Credits is optional and includes additional fees to the college/university offering the credit. Information and forms necessary for applying for these units/credits are provided to individuals upon registration.

Continuing Education Units are offered through St. Mary’s College in California for \$33 per unit (totaling \$99 for three units).

Graduate Credits are offered through Seattle Pacific University in Washington state for \$60 per credit (for a total of \$180 for three credits).
